

Supply List for Paper Collage Workshop with Judy Verhoeven February 21-23, 2024

Required

- 1 wooden cradle panel: 12 x 12 or 11 x 14 inches are good sizes, but you may choose the size you prefer. More affordable option is canvas boards. They are inexpensive and good for trying a variety of techniques because they usually can be bought in multi-board packs.
- Acrylic paint - not oil or watercolor.
****If you already have acrylic paint, then bring what you have. If not - Acrylic paint in tubes or liquid acrylics in bottles are both fine. Titanium white is more opaque than Zinc white. IF you don't have any acrylic paint you may want to get a starter set which includes good mixing colors plus black and white. Liquitex in tubes works well for gel printing.*
- Paper: copy paper, new or recycled
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Eraser
- Plastic palette knife
- 1" brush and variety of other brush sizes of your choice
- Paper towels
- Masking tape
- Plastic card, such as a used gift card or expired credit card

Optional

- Maps, sewing patterns, tissue paper, sheet music, magazine or book pages
- Tweezers
- Wax mark making tools (white crayon, a white candle)
- Paint pens
- Water soluble pencil
- Stamps, home-made or purchased, suitable for paint
- 8" x 10" inch Gelli brand plate (not Speedball) and 4" brayer roller. NOTE: 8" x 10" Gel plates and brayer rollers will be provided for use during the workshop. All will be available for purchase at the end of our class.
